



## Mr. Delane Erby

July 11, 1971 - February 18, 2025

On Tuesday, February 18th, Delane Erby, passed away at Crestwood Medical Center in Huntsville at the age of 53.

Delane Erby lived his life with a deep sense of love, commitment, and service. At just 18, he embraced fatherhood, stepping into the role of provider, husband, and, eventually, grandfather—each title bringing him joy beyond measure. His family was his greatest pride, and he dedicated himself to them wholeheartedly.

From the age of 16, Delane found purpose in serving his community as a volunteer firefighter with the Grant Fire Department. That commitment to helping others never wavered, and he continued to serve in any way he could until the day he gained his wings. His impact on those around him will never be forgotten.

Of all the roles he held, being "Papa D" to his two beautiful grandbabies was his favorite. They were the light of his life, and every day with them was a gift he cherished.

Delane also shared a love story that could fill the pages of a book. Since the moment he met Chastity—he was 18, she was 16—they built a bond that stood the test of time. Their love was unwavering, a rare and beautiful

example of devotion that inspired everyone who knew them.

Delane leaves behind a legacy of love, sacrifice, and service. He will be deeply missed but forever remembered in the hearts of those who were lucky enough to know him.

Those left to cherish his memory include his love wife, Chastity Erby; his son, Justin (Katherine) Erby; his daughter, Jaden (Joseph) Smith; a grandson, J.D. Smith; a granddaughter; Josie Smith; his parents, Freddie and Ann Erby; a brother, Richard (Chrissy) Erby; and a host of nieces, nephews, extended family and friends. He was preceded in death by his grandparents, Jess and Cora Lee Erby and Anna Belle Evans.

Visitation will be held on Friday, February 21, 2025, from 12:00 - 2:30 p.m. at Grant Memorial Chapel. Funeral services to follow at 3:00 p.m. with Bro. Jerry O'Neal officiating. Burial will take place in Free Home Cemetery. 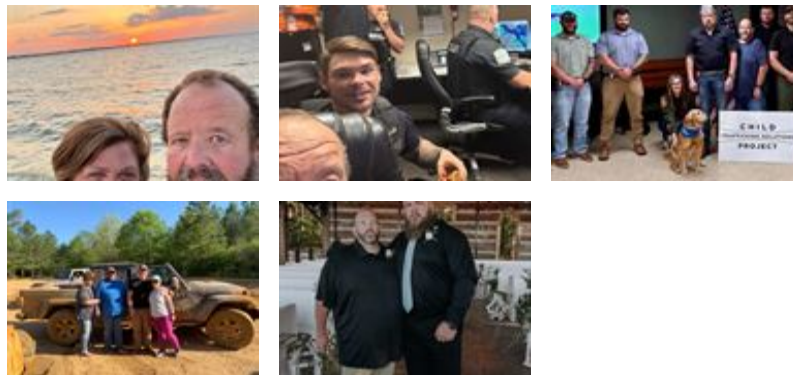
