Mrs. Michele Lynn Atchley passed away on Thursday, January 5, 2017 at Barfield Health Care. Mrs. Atchley was 52 years old. 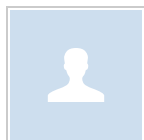

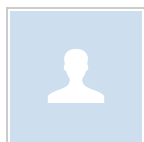
