



Mr. Robert "Robby" E. Moody

August 5, 1968 - February 15, 2024

Robert Ernest Moody, 55, of Huntsville, Alabama, passed away peacefully on Thursday, February 15, 2024, at Huntsville Hospital, surrounded by friends and family. Despite being a skilled driver, Mr. Moody experienced a cardiac event while driving that precipitated the catastrophic car crash that led to his death. He had been driving home after jogging on a nature trail, a habit he had maintained for 12 years.

Mr. Moody was as generous in death as he was in life: His final contribution was that of organ and tissue donation. Legacy of Hope facilitated Mr. Moody's gift of life; the Alabama nonprofit coordinates organ and tissue donations for transplant and research.

Public visitation will be held from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m., Friday, February 23 at Grant Memorial Chapel 4930 Main Street in Grant, Alabama. The funeral service will be held at 11 a.m., Saturday, Feb. 24 with Rev. Sherill Clontz officiating. Guests may arrive at 10 a.m. for visitation before the service. Following the service, the casket will be escorted by motorcade to Forrest Cemetery, Gadsden, where Mr. Moody will be interred following a 2 p.m. graveside service, also officiated by Rev. Sherill Clontz.

Mr. Moody was preceded in death by his parents, Clara Faye and Robert Edgar Moody. He is survived by his wife of 15 years, Karen Parr-Moody, and

daughter, Stella Lucy Moody. His is also survived by a sister, Teri Lynn Whitehead (Randy), and two nieces, Emily Catherine Fegeley (Alex) and Sarah Elizabeth Campbell. Additionally, Mr. Moody is survived by his mother-in-law, Judith Gail Parr, and brother-in-law, Stephen Philip Parr.

Mr. Moody attended the University of Alabama in Huntsville, where he graduated magna cum laude in civil engineering. He later achieved a master's degree in construction management at Auburn University. He enjoyed a 15-year career as a civil engineer for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. In his spare time, Mr. Moody loved to garden, jog, fish, golf and, most of all, spend time with family.

Pallbearers will include James Clontz, Craig Clontz, Ben Saint, Marc Winkles, Hank Thomsen and Mike Mollineaux.
